I've talked to our President, "Andy" Anderson, Vice President, Ralph Smith, and treasurer, Mike Magazzine and everything is GO for Reno.

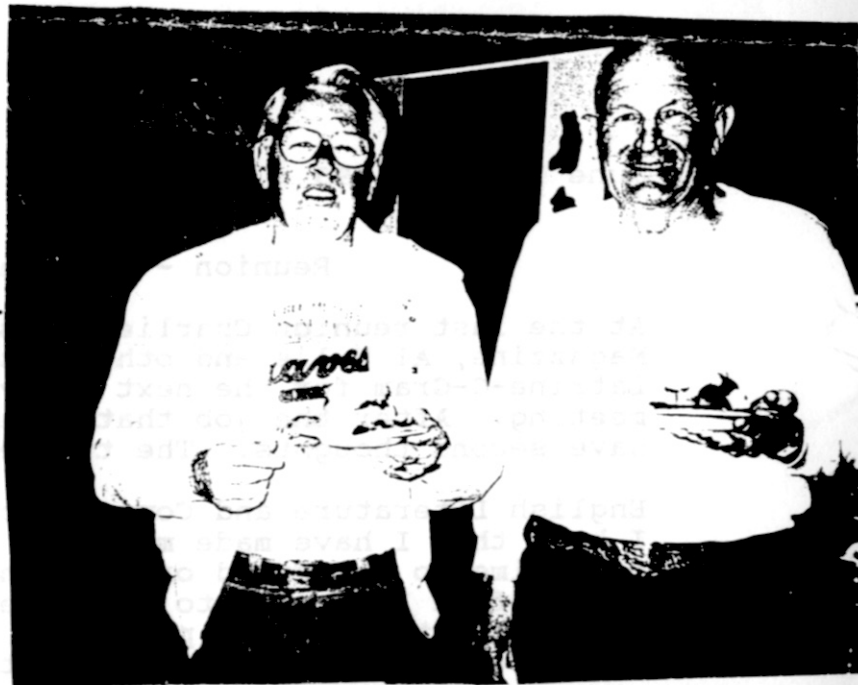
Enclosed is the schedule (again) and where to make reservations. (Sands Regency Hotel Casino).
