LeROY CRENSHAW-a 50 mission Gunner was born 1-18-22 made his final flite to Eagles Nest 4-27-08. On May 10, 2008 his ashes were placed near his beloved wife Josephine and grand-daughter in the Crenshaw-Hayman plot in Forest Park East Cemetary, Webster, TX. LeRoy will be remembered as a Gunner on the Duckworth Crew. While flying with Colonel Chuck Clark the 465th BG Commanding Officer on the 9-13-44 raid to Oswiecim, Poland they received severe battle damage necessitating their making a forced landing in Poland. Initially, they were declared POWs. Mother Luck was riding with them and rather than becoming German POWs they were fortunate to be in Russian territory and taken to Potova, Russia. At the time his baby daughter Sandra was less than one month old. Having gone down in a B-24 this crew made some history when Colonel Clark using his rank and position as a Bomb Group Commander coomanded a B-17 with a

load of bombs; tacked on to a 8th Air Force Bomb Group making a Shuttle raid; and during their return trip made a successful bomb run. In the early 50s LeRoy was recalled to active duty during the Korean conflict. During this tour he was stationed at Nellis Air Base, Las Vegas, NV where he was an AP Mechanic working on fighter jets. He is survived by his daughter Sandra Hayman (Larry) and son Leonard Crenshaw (Lisa); grandchildren Nicol & Ryan Hayman and Karen & Leonard Crenshaw (Johanna); along with 7 great-granchildren. He was employed as a Machinist with Hunt Tool Company 24 years and with Eastman Whipstock 18 years before retiring. With Josephine having passed on earlier in the summer of 2007 his health failed necessitating his entering Friendship Haven loacated in Friendswood, TX where he was content & happy having an unlimited number of fellow Senior citizens to 'jawbone' with. **WE HAVE LOST ANOTHER OF THE BEST !**

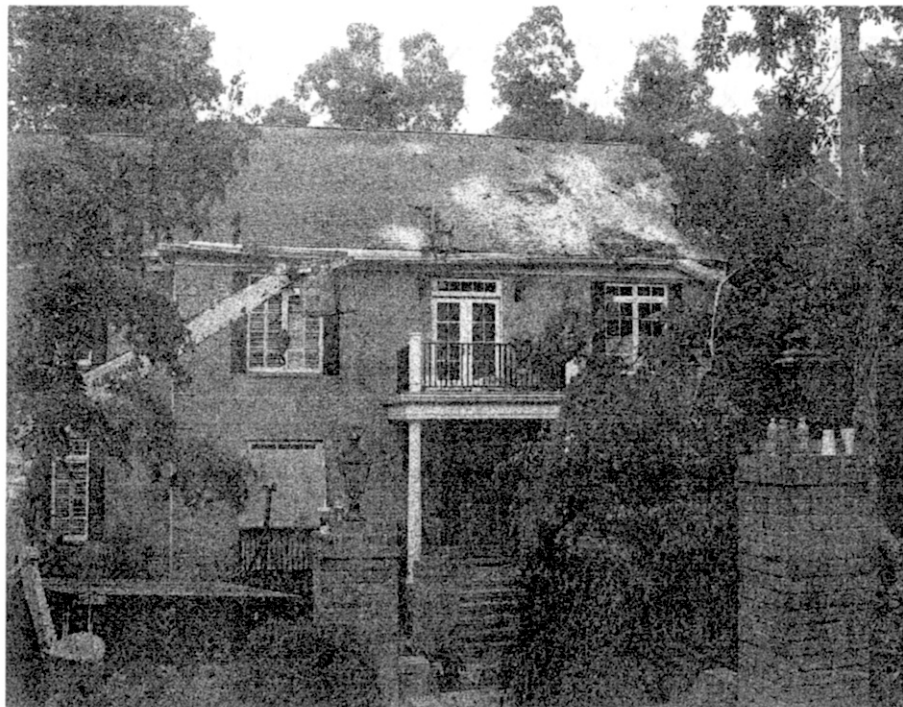

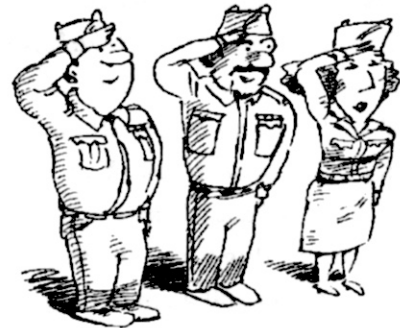
