Bobby & Frank Kara were the pilots on the 16th crew of the 17 originals to join the Squadron. With only 15 planes his & the Greenwood crew the 17th didn't rate planes and made the trip to Pantanella by Liberty Ship, Cattle Car & marching. When operations commenced and the toughter targets began taking their toll—the 16 & 17th crews stepped upand caught many double missions; by July were leading in number of missions. In the 3rd week of August Bob Haefner & Frank Kara were not only the first crew of the original 17 to complete 50 missions—but—were the only crew of the 17 to return all ten of their crew back to the USA. Quite a record. Bobby went on to prove this fete was no luck rising to an executive position with Atlantic Richfield Oil company. He was a great guy then-and-a great guy today.

Few if any outfits can boast of a better supporting member and family members than the 783rd with Gene & his great family. With their taking part over the years in the many reunions they have endeared themselves to the membership. Can you believe the 'Ole POW' has always called them & refers to each by the numerical number in which they were born? Thanks to the best half of that deal-Mary— giving them names at birth. Likewise, it wasn't until approximately a year or so back it was learned he had unselfishly placed an unknown injured fellow POW from the 8th Air Force in a wagon and pulled him in the snow & ice for 2 months of that cold winter of 1944-45 when they took the POWs out of their camps & marched them thru the snow & ice from barn to barn all winter.
